SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- ① Each Powell River City / qathet Regional District / Tla'amin Nation resident is entitled to submit one picture. The picture must be in digital format. (Print pictures can be scanned at the Library).
- ② It must be taken in the City of Powell River, the qathet Regional District or the territory of the Tla'amin Nation and showcase what is characteristic about this territory and/or its community.
- ③ The main focus of the picture should be animals (wildlife, pets or farm animals). Any identifiable people in the picture must provide a photo release with the submission, authorizing the Library permission to publish the photo.
- ④ Submissions will be judged based solely on:
 - 1) Subject Matter (representing animals from this territory and/or its community)
 - 2) Photo Composition (visual impact of the photo layout)
 - 3) Detail (sharpness, focus, depth of field, photo resolution)
 - 4) Lighting (colour, brightness, contrast, saturation)
- ⑤ The image file should be **larger** than 2 MB and have a **landscape orientation** in order to meet the resolution required to be a finalist.
- ⑥ Only entries submitted by the deadline of noon on Friday, June 7, 2019 will be eligible.

COMPETITION PRIZES & RULES

Twelve finalist pictures will be selected and judged anonymously by a panel of experts who will choose a winning photo by equally balancing the four criteria in Guideline ④.

- ***The winning picture will be published in Powell River Living and will be displayed at the Library.***
- ***The winning photographer will receive a 75\$ gift certificate prize for Mother Nature.***
- ***Twelve finalists will have their pictures published in a 2020 Library calendar.***

The winning photo and the finalists will be unveiled at the Library at an event on Friday June 14. All of the finalists will be invited to the announcement of the winning photo where all of twelve of the finalist photos will be digitally displayed. By submitting, you grant the Powell River Public Library permission to publish your photo in promotional material. You will retain all rights and ownership of the photo you submit. All personal information submitted will be kept strictly confidential and will not be used for any purposes outside of the Powell River Photography Competition.
